on the draft Rulebook on the detailed content and guidelines for determining national targets of the Integrated National Energy and Climate Plan, the method of its preparation and reporting on its implementation

Pursuant to Article 8b of the Law on Energy ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", Nos. 145/14, 95/18 – other law, 40/21, 35/23 – other law, 62/23, 94/24 and 109/25 – other law), the Ministry of Mining and Energy adopted in 2022 the Rulebook on the detailed content and guidelines for determining national targets of the Integrated National Energy and Climate Plan, the method of its preparation and reporting on its implementation ("Official Gazette of the Republic of Serbia", No. 49/2022).

In December 2024, the adapted EU Regulation (EU) 2022/2299 was adopted, defining the areas and types of data required for reporting on the implementation of the Integrated National Energy and Climate Plan of the Republic of Serbia. In addition, the European Commission and the Energy Community Secretariat established the REPORTNET and REPORTENER applications for this purpose.

In light of these developments, it was necessary to align the existing Rulebook with the new reporting requirements.

The Draft Rulebook transposes the adapted Regulation (EU) 2022/2299 into the national legal framework and establishes a national reporting system. This system defines the roles and responsibilities of:

- the national reporting coordinator – the Ministry of Mining and Energy – responsible for coordinating the preparation, monitoring and reporting on the Integrated National Energy and Climate Plan;
- lead and assistant rapporteurs, appointed by decision of the Ministry from among its employees, responsible for completing one or more reporting templates related to monitoring progress in the implementation of the Plan;
- ministries and other state authorities, public enterprises, energy entities, local self-government units and, where necessary, other entities (hereinafter: data providers), responsible for submitting data and information within their respective competences.

The Draft Rulebook further regulates:

- deadlines for the submission of data and information;
- verification procedures for data used in reporting on the implementation of the Plan;
- reporting formats;
- the content and scope of reporting on the progress of the Integrated National Energy and Climate Plan.
